We have some things left from last year so we do not need erasers, pencils or pens.

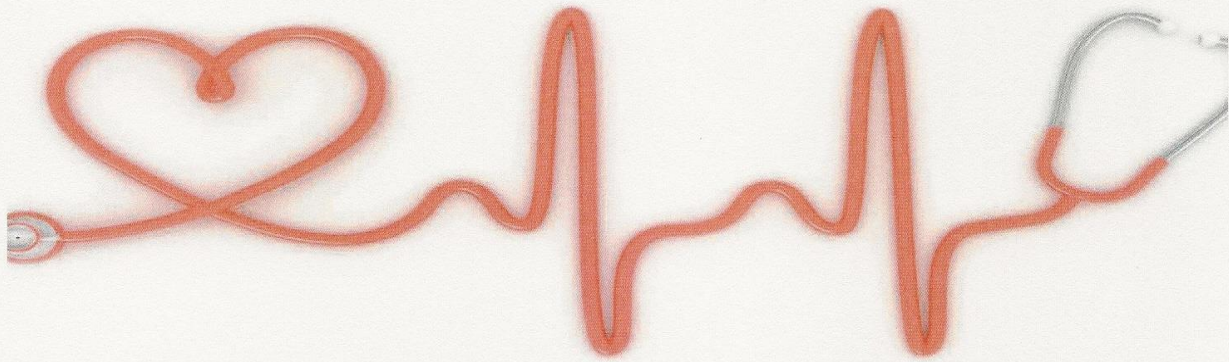
