Congregational meeting set for January 28, 2018.

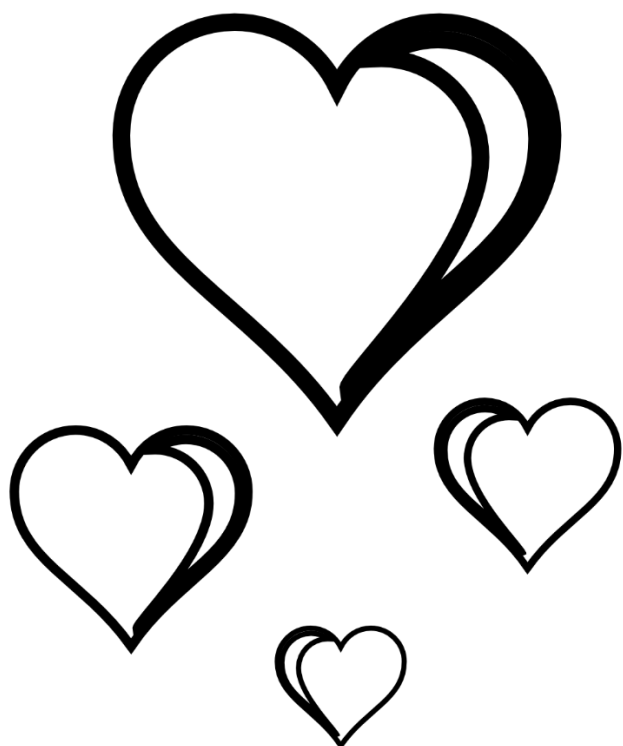
Pastor Tom made a motion that a PayPal account be set up for TLC and for it to be introduced at the annual meeting. Sue Deaton second. Motion carried.
