

During Lent and Holy Week we learned and shared in many Jewish holy days. We conclude our series with the Festival of Pentecost, or in the Jewish faith: Shavuot. Shavuot is seven weeks after Passover. Shavuot literally means "weeks" and is a reminder of the link between these two pilgrimage festivals. The focus is the giving of the Torah at Mount Sinai.

The Saint John's Bible is a work of art and a work of theology. A team of artists coordinated by Donald Jackson in Wales and a team of scholars in central Minnesota have brought together the ancient techniques of calligraphy and illumination with an ecumenical Christian approach to the Bible rooted in Benedictine spirituality.
