None of us want a disaster to happen, but when they do, it can make all the difference in the world if we are as prepared for it as we can possibly be.

Deb Moran and Sharon Monroe joined Fairbury pastors (Trinity Lutheran, 1st Presbyterian, 1st United Methodist, Faith Fellowship, and 1st Baptist) at our August meeting to discuss disaster preparedness. Sharon presented information congregations and pastors should consider as part of their planning.

Deb invites us to become a part of the **City of Fairbury's Disaster Response** team. It is Deb's hope that at least 4 persons / congregation would consider being a part of the City's Disaster Response. A waiver and volunteer form have to be completed by any interested parties; they are available through Pastor Tom or Debbie Brandt.

Information that you will need to complete include:

- name & address
- date of birth
- phone #s
- whether you are 18 years of age or older (apparently a requirement)
- whether you would be available to work days – evenings – nights
- how many hours and days you can work
- if you have physical limitations
- if you have computer skills
- if you have an aversion to heights, and
- if you are affected by weather extremes.

A background check is mandatory for all volunteers.

If you would like to be a part of Fairbury's response to disasters, this is your opportunity to become prepared as well.
